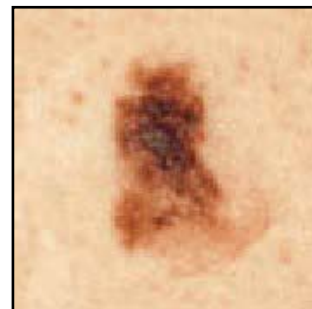
Facts About Skin Cancer

- Over **382,000** people are treated for non-melanoma skin cancer and melanoma each year in Australia
- Nearly **1400** people die each year from Skin Cancer

- Sunspots
- Freckles
- Moles
- Skin that changes colour
